



Statement regarding the Draft Italian Declaration of Internet Rights

The Just Net Coalition¹ (JNC) comprises several dozen civil society organisations and individuals from different regions globally, concerned with issues of Internet governance, from the perspective of all human rights, including democracy and economic and social justice.

In October 2014, the Study Committee on Internet Rights and Duties of Italy's Chamber of Deputies published a draft Declaration of Internet Rights².

Although some points could and probably should be strengthened further, the Just Net Coalition (JNC) endorses and supports the current contents of the draft. They should certainly not be weakened.

We commend the authors of this draft and note that it is entirely consistent with major elements of our Delhi Declaration³, in particular paragraphs 1, 9, 13 to 17, and 23.

JNC looks forward to the publication of the final version of this Declaration.
